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# **DRIVING DIRECTIONS**

When attending athletic events at Cardinal Newman, please advise coaches, drivers and training staff of the following:

#### **Directions to Cardinal Newman**

From Palm Beach Lakes Blvd: Head South on Spencer Drive Make a left on Sequoia Drive Turn Right at the sign for "Cardinal Newman Athletic Facilities"

From Okeechobee Blvd: Head North on Spencer Drive Make a right on Sequoia Drive Turn Right at the sign for "Cardinal Newman Athletic Facilities"

#### **Team Bus Drop Off & Parking**

- Team bus will enter the Student Parking Lot Gate (M) from Sequoia Drive
- Head straight into the Bus Parking Area to drop off the team.
- Bus will stay in this designated area until the completion of the athletic event.

#### **Spectator Parking**

All general parking for spectators at Cardinal Newman athletic events will be available in the Student Parking Lot (M).



### **VOLLEYBALL MATCH PROCEDURES**

#### **PRE-MATCH SCREENING**

- Cardinal Newman athletes will be screened 60 minutes prior to start time
- Opponents will be screened and temperature checked upon arrival to campus.
- Once screening is complete, participants should not leave the gymnasium.
- Officials will also be screened upon arrival.

#### **PRE-MATCH CONFERENCE WITH OFFICIALS**

- One coach per team, both officials. No players should attend
- Conference should take place at center court with 1 coach, 1 official on each side of the net and socially distanced
- Visiting team will serve first and alternate opening serves through first 4 sets
- Opening serve of 5th set will be determined by coin toss at center court with 1 player from each team and the down ref attending. The home team will call the coin toss

#### **SIDELINES / BENCHES**

- Chairs will be spaced 6 feet apart and staggered in rows.
- Hand sanitizer and sanitizing wipes will be available by each bench.
- Masks should be worn by all coaches, managers, and players not in the game.
- Disposable cups and/or bottled water will be provided on the sideline. Cups should be pre-filled by a team designated individual.
- Players should not touch coolers or share water bottles / cups
- Scorers tables will be set for social distancing.

#### **MATCH PROCEDURES**

- Teams will not switch benches or sides.
- Substitutions should take place socially distanced at the attack line.
- No Touch Rule high fives and huddles should not take place.
- Timeouts should be socially distanced
- Match volleyballs should be sanitized between sets.

#### **POST MATCH PROCEDURES**

- No postgame handshake lines.
- Teams should depart campus immediately following the match.

## **GENERAL PROCEDURES FOR ALL INDOOR EVENTS**

- Athletes are required to complete the Covid-19 Daily Monitoring Form and have temperature checked prior to games.
- Visiting Teams are responsible for ensuring the health of all members entering the building.
- All individuals are subject to a temperature check prior to entering the building.
- All individuals who are not members of the team participating in the contest (parents, guardians, scorekeepers, film crew, etc.) are required to wear masks while inside the building.
- Visiting Volleyball and Basketball Teams (if approved by Athletics Director) will be assigned to a specific locker room for use prior to, during and after the game. (*No lockers rooms will be used at this time*)
- Bleacher use will be limited during competitions to six feet in distance and every third row. Sections not in use will be marked to ensure that spectators do not use them.
- Bench Chairs will be placed in rows and staggered with each chair socially distanced. Players must wear masks when on the sideline.
- Team that is not playing (i.e. JV or Varsity) shall sit in bleachers behind their team bench and remain socially distanced.
- Score Table Personnel will be spaced appropriately to ensure social distancing.
- Score Table Personnel are required to wear face masks at all times.
- The Athletic Administrator/Coaching Staff on duty is responsible for spraying the bench chairs and the score table equipment after each game. Spectators will be asked to leave the gym between games while the bleachers are cleaned.
- Basketballs and Volleyballs should be replaced after each timeout, quarter, or set and should be cleaned appropriately.
- It is up to the Athletic Department if the Concession Stand will be opened during games. Only individuals who have been approved by the Athletic Department will be permitted in the Concession Stand. All individuals working the Concession stand will be required to wear a face mask and gloves at all times. Only prepackaged food and drinks will be available. (Concessions stand is closed at this time)
- A water cooler and cups will be provided for use during all games. Athletes should bring their own water bottle.
- No handshakes with the opposing team prior to or following the athletic competition.
- The Athletic Administrator is responsible for cleaning any area used by the officials during the game.
