GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Graduates must complete 28 credits including:






THE PURPOSE

BENEFITS OF THE PROGRAM

- program of study that provides a wellrounded college preparatory education with the ability to engage in rigorous academic courses including AP, Dual Enrollment, and Honors courses.
- Four-year scholarships may be awarded to recipients who qualify for the program.
- A full-time program director and dedicated faculty members who act as mentors and advisers to the scholars on an individual basis paired with a fouryear college counseling program. Resume building, test-taking skills, essay writing, and college admission/application guidance will be the focus of these visits.
- An opportunity for freshmen to take advantage of an advanced placement course, with a second course applicable to sophomores.
