# **Our Plan**

As we celebrate 60 years of shaping hearts and minds, Phase One of our plan to update and renew Cardinal Newman High School will undertake renovating the North Academic Building. The extent of these exciting enhancements to promote greater accessibility is illustrated in the following pages. The work will begin immediately, as funding allows.

### **Academic Classrooms**









The main entrance into the North Academic Building will be relocated off the main driveway, across from the Sister Ann Richard Alumni Center and just beyond the beloved banyan tree.

The new main entrance will open into a spacious, two-story foyer and welcome area which will better facilitate easy entry into the breezeway leading into the South Building.

Attractive and functional space adjacent to the main entrance will include a welcome area, admissions center, and offices for student services and college advising.

Central air conditioning and a fire suppression system will be installed throughout the North Academic Building. The counselling center and college advising offices will be relocated to the newly renovated and more functional space.

The Chapel will be prominently positioned in the North Building with adjacent offices for the Campus Ministry team.

The Appeal will fund the creation of state-of-the-art laboratories for biology, chemistry, and physics.

An Innovation Lab will facilitate robotics, hands-on learning and enhance STEMrelated offerings.

Second floor classrooms and faculty offices, including those utilized by the Mathematics Department, will be updated.

### A Special Commitment

We are asking every member of the Cardinal Newman family to consider a five-year pledge commitment to help us achieve our goal. Your generosity will lay the foundation for the Appeal's success. As you discern your commitment, please remember the following:

- Your commitment may be paid over a five-year (60-month) period.
- We will send you regular payment reminders in accordance with the payment schedule you indicate.
- Shaping the Future is a special project that requires funding over and above our typical annual revenue streams. As you budget your pledge, please know that we will invite you to participate in the Annual Crusader Fund, as you continue to make payments toward your Shaping the Future Appeal pledge. Annual school fundraising events such as the Newman Night Gala will also continue as donors make and fufill pledges to the Shaping the Future Appeal.

### Tax Advantages of Thoughtful Giving

#### Tax Deductions

Annual contributions to this Appeal are fully tax-deductible (except in the instance of the IRA charitable rollover, further explained below).

#### IRA Charitable Rollover

If you have a non-Roth IRA and are aged 72 or older, you must take a required minimum distribution (RMD) every year. You are permitted to make a qualified charitable distribution (QCD) to satisfy all or part of your annual RMD. Through a QCD, you may transfer up to \$100,000 per year to Cardinal Newman High School. As a charitable gift, this distribution comes straight from your IRA to Newman. It does not pass through your hands and therefore is not taxed as income, but it does count toward your annual required minimum distribution. Since the funds are not claimed as income, the IRA rollover cannot be deducted on your tax return.

#### Gifts of Stock

Gifts of appreciated stock allow you to avoid the capital gains tax as you support the Crusaders. Newman immediately sells the stock for its current market value, and you can deduct that same current value from your taxes.

### Matching Gifts

Many employers offer matching gift programs that provide employees and retirees the opportunity to multiply their gifts to educational institutions. We encourage all donors to apply for matching funds directly with their human resources department. Once your gift is received at Cardinal Newman, our Development Office can provide the necessary verification your company may require to approve your application.







