Dear Students and Families,

We are extremely excited to welcome you to the Cardinal Newman family! In this letter, you will find information pertaining to the Crusader Summer Institute (C.S.I.).

Drop Off & Pick Up

You may drop off your student no earlier than 7:30 a.m. at the bus loop at the front of the school. Please use the entrance on Spencer Drive. Pick-up begins at 1 p.m. at the same location as drop-off. There will be no supervision past 1:30 p.m.

Mask Policy

Masks are optional indoors for those who are vaccinated.

Dress Code Policy

Students should wear clothing that is modest and appropriate for a Catholic School. 1.

Students are permitted to wear full-length, denim blue jeans as long as they are neat in appearance, are 2. not ripped or frayed, and do not have holes worn through them.

Low necklines and exposed shoulders are not permitted (no tank tops). 3.

There should be no printed decoration supporting divisive topics and illegal and/or inappropriate 4. activity.

Shorts should extend below the fingertip for both ladies and gentlemen. 5.

Skin-tight clothing is not to be worn as part of the uniform or non-uniform apparel. Students may not 6. wear any clothing that exposes the midriff or any other significant part of the body.

Slippers, slides, and boots are not permitted. Due to safety issues, students with backless shoes, flip

flops, or slides will not be permitted to attend class. No bare toes or heels are permitted. 8. On Friday, 6/10, students should wear their C.S.I. spirit shirt which they will receive on Monday, 6/6.

Cell Phone Policy

Since this is an academic program, students will be asked to turn off their cell phones during their class times. Students will have access to their cell phones before 8 a.m. and after 1 p.m.

Behavioral Expectations

Cardinal Newman High School assumes that students intend to do their best in all areas of school life. Students and their parents are expected to willingly support the school's philosophy, policies, and rules. Registered students are Catholic school representatives 24 hours a day, seven days a week, and are responsible for acting in a way that brings credit to both church and school. Inappropriate conduct, whether inside or outside of the school, that is detrimental to the school's reputation is not tolerable and is subject to disciplinary action.
