Social Science: 3 - 5 credits, including World History, US History, American Government & Economics

**Science + Social Science must equal 8 credits.*

Foreign Language: 2 credits

Religion: 4 credits (8 semesters)

Practical/Performing Arts: 1 credit

Health/PE: 1 credit

Community Service: 25 hours per year.
